1. 1000m / 200m straight racing events will be held in the following categories:-  
Male - K1/C1 and K2/C2 - U14 - U16 - U18 - U23 - Senior - Sub Veteran - Veteran - Sub-Master - Master - Sub-Grand Master - Grand Master – Great Grand Master
2. 500m / 200m straight racing events will be held in the following categories:-  
Female- K1 and K2 - U14 - U16 - U18 - U23 - Senior - Sub Veteran - Veteran - Sub-Master - Master - Sub-Grand Master - Grand Master – Great Grand Master
3. Male and Female – Guppy 200m and 500m - U8 and U10 and U12

Categories will be combined where insufficient entries are received. Three boats are required for a category to be raced. Awards will be in accordance with the latest CSA regulations - 3 boats for Gold and 5 for Silver and Bronze as well. Age groups are all calculated according to the current ICF age category rules.

## **SOME BASIC RULES.**

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the latest ICF rules for flat-water racing.
2. Competitors other than guppies must be registered members of a Canoe Club affiliated to CSA.
3. Competitors may only participate in the events they have entered for.
4. All kayaks must conform to CSA specifications.
5. All kayaks must be fitted with a number slide on the back deck. Any competitor arriving at the start with an incorrectly numbered kayak will not be allowed to start.
6. Where less than 12 kayaks have entered for an event the heats and semi-finals will fall away and straight finals will be run.
7. All guppy paddlers must wear life-jackets.
8. All Medal winners must be appropriately dressed when coming to receive their prizes (i.e. certificates, trophy's, medals)
  - Closed shoes only (no slops, sandals or bare feet)
  - Long pants or chino shorts (no baggies, paddling shorts or towels)
  - Appropriate top (no vests, paddling tops or topless)

The Dam is controlled by Msinsi Holdings - a subsidiary of Umgeni Water. Access is via their control point near the head of the dam. The camping area is immediately adjacent to the regatta area.
